

Sioux Valley Energy Board Chair—Cliff Nock Resigns

Colman, S.D. – Sioux Valley Energy board president, Cliff Nock of Valley Springs, S.D. has resigned his leadership role and board seat due to illness. The resignation is effective immediately.
