	□ 3. ACT and/or SAT exam scores are not required to be considered for a technical college or two-year community college scholarship.
	■ 4. Essay question – One of the seven cooperative principles is 'Concern for Community'. As an individual, how have you lived out that principle in your own life? Please use specific examples from your own life/experience. Essays must be written utilizing original thought. Artificial intelligence (AI) applications, such as Chat GPT, are not allowed. If it is determined that an artificial intelligence assistance program is used to answer the question, your scholarship application will be disqualified. Essay MUST be typed (handwritten essays will not be accepted.)
	☐ 5. Letter of Reference – Include a letter of reference from a teacher, school counselor, employer, youth leader, or pastor.
	 6. Application must be signed by either a parent or legal guardian for the student to be considered. The parent or guardian must be a Sioux Valley Energy member.
